OF THE HIGHWAY LIES CLOSER THAN 100 FEET TO THE S. R. R.R. RIGHT OF WAY, TRAVERSING
THE SAN CARLOS INDIAN RESERVATION IN GILA COUNTY, ARIZONA, SUBJECT TO ALL
VALID EXISTING RIGHTS BUT RESERVING RIGHTS OF WAY FOR CANALS AND DITCHES
CROSSING SAID RIGHT OF WAY AND CONSTRUCTED BY AUTHORITY OF THE UNITED
STATES.
