View looking north at Ignacio M. Baumea from Calle Torim.

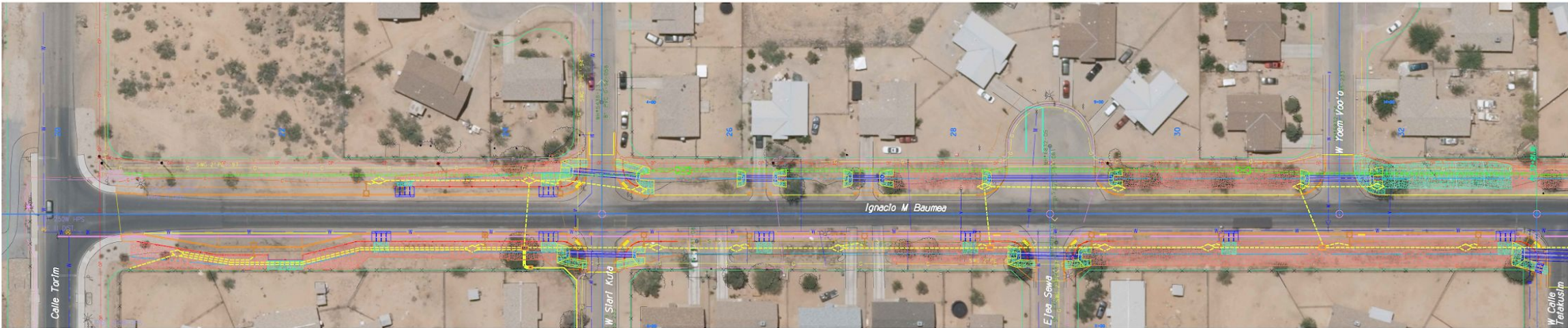


- Design completed Fall 2022

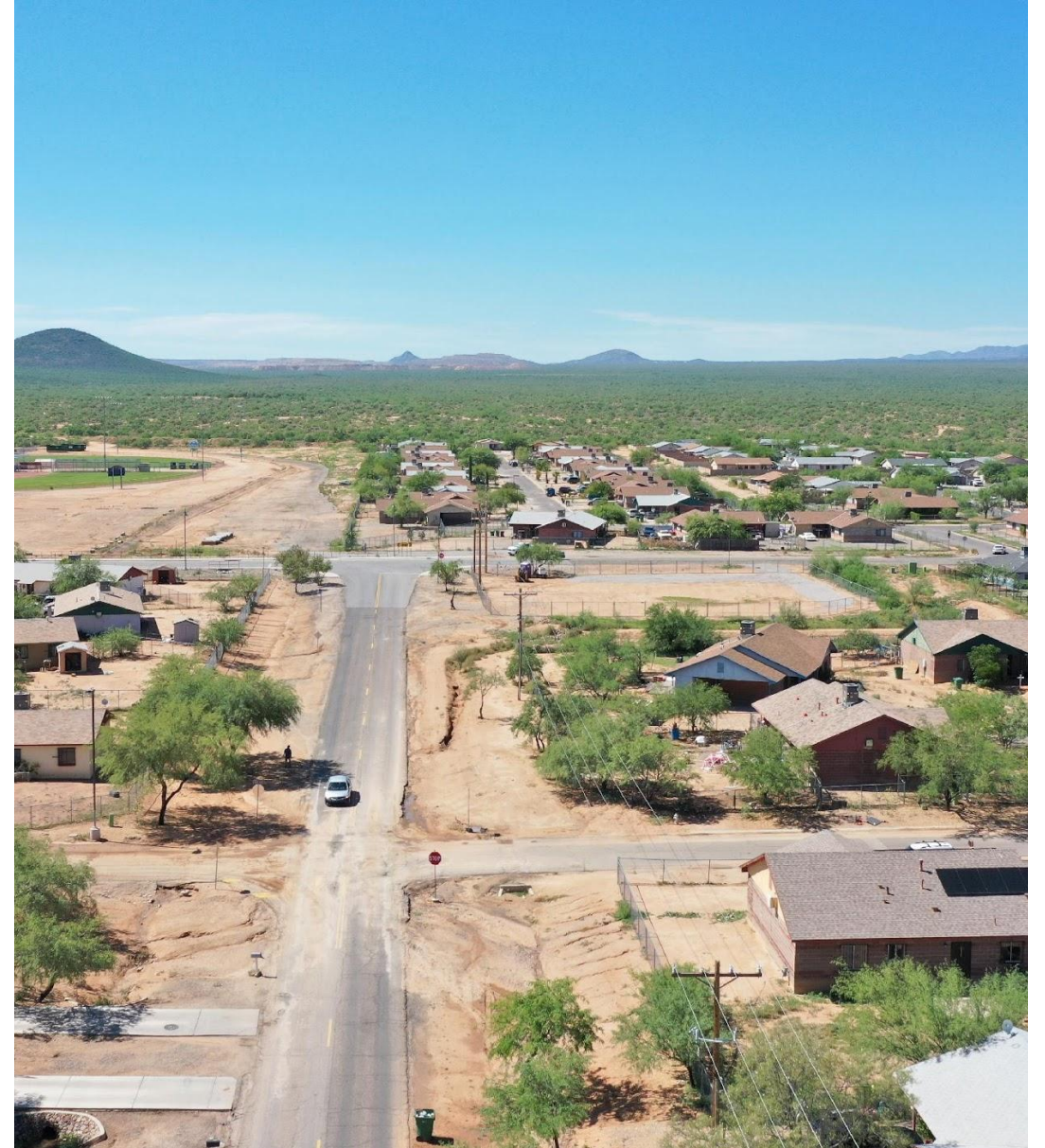
