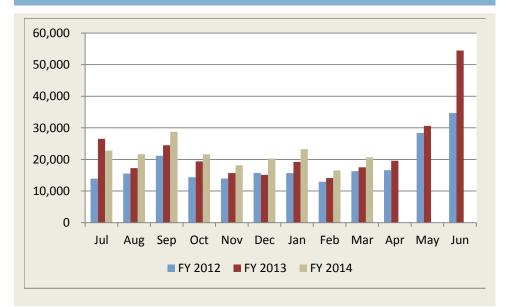

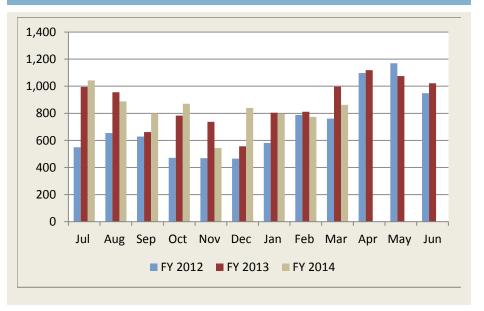

Maricopa County New Single-Family Building Permits

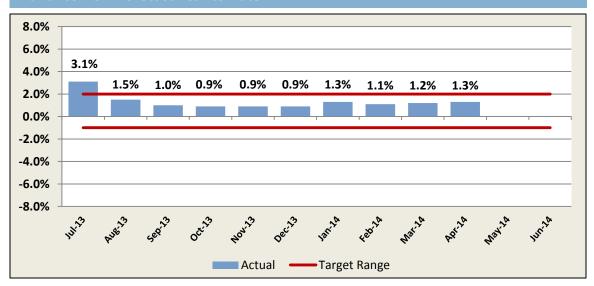


HIGHWAY USER REVENUE FUND (HURF) THROUGH APRIL 30, 2014

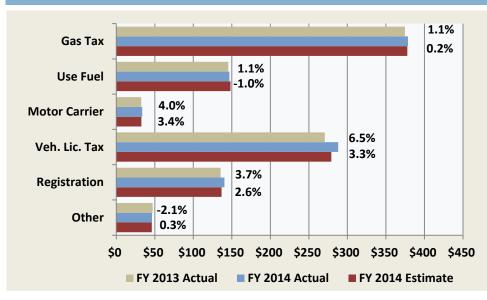
Highlights

- HURF collections totaled \$1.03 billion for the first ten months of FY 2014, an increase of 2.8 percent above the same period last fiscal year and 1.3 percent above the estimate.
- HURF revenues were \$113.3 million in April, an increase of 3.7 percent above April of last year and 2.5 percent above the estimate.
- Gas prices in Arizona increased in April, with the statewide average price per gallon reaching \$3.48 for regular unleaded gas. This is two cents less than the Arizona average price per gallon for regular unleaded gasoline in April of last year.

Revenue Category Performance Year to Date (\$ in Millions)



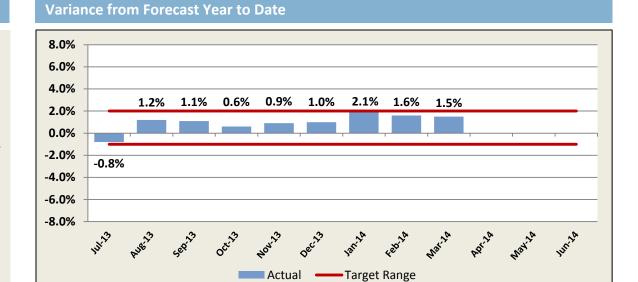

MARICOPA COUNTY TRANSPORTATION EXCISE TAX (RARF) THROUGH MARCH 31, 2014

Highlights

- Contracting revenues were 3.3 percent above the estimate for the first three quarters of FY 2014, and 17.3 percent above the same period last year. A total of 773 single-family building permits were issued within Maricopa County in February of 2014 per U.S. Census Bureau estimates.
- According to the Arizona Department of Administration, the unemployment rate in the greater Phoenix area was 6.1 percent in February 2014, which was lower than the 6.9 percent reported in February 2013.
- Phoenix Sky Harbor passenger count was 3.15 million in February 2014, approximately 89,000 more than in February 2013.
