#### **ECONOMIC HIGHLIGHTS**


#### **Arizona Indicators**

- Combined container volume at the Port of Los Angeles and the Port of Long Beach was 26.7 percent lower in July 2023 than in July 2022.
- The U.S. Energy Information Administration reported the price of West Coast No. 2 diesel was \$4.53 per gallon in July 2023, down from \$6.19 per gallon in July 2022.
- The Arizona average price per gallon for regular unleaded gas was \$3.80 in July 2023, compared to \$4.87 in July 2022.
- The Arizona seasonally adjusted unemployment rate, as reported by the Arizona Office of Economic Opportunity, decreased to 3.6 percent in July 2023, down from the 3.9 percent experienced in July 2022.


#### **Greater Phoenix Area Indicators**

- The number of new single-family building permits issued in Maricopa County in July 2023 was up 22.6 percent compared to the same month of 2022.
- The monthly employment report published by the Arizona Office of Economic Opportunity stated the construction sector in the Greater Phoenix Area gained 5,900 jobs year-over-year from July 2022 to July 2023, an increase of 3.8 percent.
- The Greater Phoenix Area unadjusted unemployment rate was 4.2 percent in July 2023, up from 3.7 percent in July 2022.

#### Maricopa County New Single-Family Building Permits






### HIGHWAY USER REVENUE FUND (HURF) THROUGH AUGUST 31, 2023


#### **Highlights**

- Year-to-date FY 2024 HURF revenues are 3 percent above forecast and 4.8 percent above the same period of FY 2023.
- Year-to-date gas tax revenues have increased 7.6 percent from FY 2023 to FY 2024 and are 5.7 percent above the forecast.
- Year-to-date vehicle license tax revenues have increased 4.3 percent from FY 2023 to FY 2024 and are 1 percent below the forecast.




#### REGIONAL AREA ROAD FUND (RARF) THROUGH JULY 31, 2023

#### **Highlights**

- Year-to-date FY 2024 RARF revenues through July surpassed the same period of FY 2023 by 2.4 percent and were 0 percent from the forecast.
- Retail sales, the largest revenue category of RARF, declined 2.7
  percent year-to-date when compared to the same period of the last
  fiscal year.
- Restaurant and Bar revenues grew 9.3 percent year-to-date when compared to the same period of the last fiscal year.
- Contracting revenues increased 15.6 percent year-to-date when compared to the same period of the last fiscal year.
- The 30 year mortgage interest rate in July 2023 was 6.84 percent, higher than the 5.41 percent experienced in July 2022.
