Interstate 10 and State Route 210 | Draft Environmental Assessment and Initial Design Concept Report Public Hearing

The Arizona Department of Transportation is hosting a public hearing about potential improvements to two important corridors that serve the Tucson area:

- Interstate 10 (I-10) from the I-10/Interstate 19 interchange to Kolb Road
- State Route 210 (SR210) (Barraza-Aviation Parkway) from Golf Links Road to a future connection with Interstate 10 along Alvernon Way

The public hearing will provide information about the Draft Environmental Assessment (EA) and Initial Design Concept Report (DCR) and give the community an opportunity to provide feedback on study issues and concepts. The Draft EA identified the environmental concerns and impacts in the study area. The Initial DCR refined and evaluated the two proposed alternatives, and also evaluated the No-Build (or "do nothing") alternative. The following actions are recommended:

- Designate Alvernon Way as SR210 from Golf Links Road to I-10 and provide four (4) travel lanes in each direction
- Add a new system interchange to provide access from SR210 to I-10
- Add up to two (2) lanes in each direction on I-10 from the I-10/I-19 interchange to Alvernon Way
- Add up to four (4) lanes in each direction on I-10 from Alvernon Way to Kolb Road

The purpose of this study is to relieve congestion and improve safety and traffic flow on I-10, and to connect SR210 with I-10 to provide an additional route into and out of the downtown Tucson area.

The Draft EA and Initial DCR are available for public comment from October 29, 2019, through December 12, 2019.

Formal comment period begins; public hearing set for Nov. 20

A proposal to make improvements to two important corridors in the Tucson area is now available for public review and comment.

The Draft Environmental Assessment and Initial Design Concept Report for Interstate 10 from I-19 to Kolb Road and State Route 210 from Golf Links Road to a future connection with I-10 along Alvernon Way are now available on the project website at azdot.gov/i10sr210study.

The Initial Design Concept Report refines and evaluates two build alternatives and a no-build ("do nothing") option. It recommends the following improvements:

- Designate Alvernon Way as SR 210 from Golf Links Road to I-10 and provide four travel lanes in each direction
- Add a new system interchange to provide access between SR 210 and I-10
- Add up to two lanes in each direction on I-10 between the I-10/I-19 interchange and Alvernon Way
- Add up to four lanes in each direction on I-10 between Alvernon Way and Kolb Road

The Draft Environmental Assessment examines potential impacts to the natural and human environments associated with the proposed improvements.

PHOENIX – A study to improve Interstate 10 and State Route 210 – and to connect the two important highways for enhanced access to downtown Tucson – is now available for public review and comment.

Two alternatives are under consideration for expanding the number of I-10 travel lanes between Alverson Way and Kolb Road. One option would build a collector-distributor road system between Alverson and Kolb, with local traffic lanes providing direct access to interchanges and express lanes for through traffic. The study team is also evaluating a no-build option, the condition that would exist if ADOT did nothing, which also serves as a comparison.

Comments received during the Draft Environmental Assessment period will be considered during the Final Environmental Assessment.





- La Interestatal 10 (I-10) desde la intersección de la I-10 y la Interestatal 19 hasta Kolb Road.
- La Ruta Estatal 210 (SR210) (Barraza-Aviation Parkway) desde Golf Links Road hasta una conexión futura con la Interestatal 10 a lo largo de Alvernon Way.

En esta audiencia pública, usted podrá obtener información sobre la Versión preliminar de la evaluación ambiental (EA) y el Informe inicial sobre el concepto del diseño (DCR) y será una oportunidad para que la comunidad pueda proporcionar sus comentarios sobre los problemas y los conceptos del estudio. La Versión preliminar de la EA identifica los problemas y los impactos ambientales en el área de estudio. El DCR inicial ajusta y evalúa las dos alternativas propuestas y la alternativa de no construcción. Se presentará la alternativa recomendada en la audiencia pública. El objetivo de este estudio es disminuir la congestión y mejorar el flujo del tránsito en la I-10, y conectar la SR210 con la I-10 para brindar una ruta adicional para ingresar y salir del área del centro de Tucson.

Aunque aún es demasiado pronto para conocer exactamente cuáles de ellas se verán afectadas, el equipo a cargo del estudio identificó aproximadamente 180 propiedades que probablemente vayan a ser afectadas por la alternativa recomendada. Los comentarios que se proporcionen antes del 12 de diciembre se incluirán en el registro del estudio. Durante la audiencia pública formal, tendrá la oportunidad de presentarse ante un panel y hacer declaraciones verbales que serán asentadas en el registro por un taquígrafo judicial. También puede enviar comentarios por escrito o en línea en la audiencia pública. Todos los métodos para enviar comentarios se consideran igualmente válido.
