The following are TIP Amendments to our 2015-2019 TIP that were approved by the TAC at our March 19<sup>th</sup> meeting:

ADOT has requested that three local railroad crossing safety improvement projects be included in our TIP. The local ADOT sponsored **Railroad Safety Projects** were added in the following manner:

**Cochise County/Davis Road MP5 (CCH15-01):** Cochise County was originally programmed for **\$5,644,583 in HPP and STP funds** to complete safety and drainage improvements to mile posts 5,9 and 13. However, estimates to complete all three miles posts exceeded available funds by approximately \$2,000,000. It was determined that MP5 and MP13 were closest to obligation and were financially feasibility. It was also determined that HPP funding could be at risk because it has been programmed for several years. The JPA was amended extracting MP 9. The estimated total cost of this project is approximately **\$4,200,000**. As per the JPA amendment, the project will be funded by using the remaining **\$2,114,338 in HPP funds** with STP covering the remaining project cost. Total STP funds needed to fund this project are **\$1,969,560** (not including local match). Total STP funds programmed are **\$3,329,021** (not including local match). This left a balance of **\$1,359,461**(not including local match) that was programmed on MP9 as a placeholder while SEAGO and the County attempt to locate the additional funds needed to complete the project.

**Safford City Traffic Sign Upgrade Project (SAF14-02):** This project was originally programmed for \$50,400. That estimate has been adjusted by ADOT. The new estimated cost for the project is \$76,855. HSIP funding is available and the TIP was amended to reflect this new cost estimate.

**Nogales Citywide Traffic Sign Replacement (NOG 14-01):** This project was originally programmed for \$52,585 in HSIP funding. Nogales was going to be able to replace less than have the needed signs without additional funding. The TAC voted to increase funding by \$70,000 to allow the City to replace all of the signs requested in the original application. Total project cost is now \$122,585.

**Thatcher Church Street Widening Project (THR12-13):** We currently have \$174,000 programmed for ROW. The DCR estimated ROW at \$532,282. The ADOT Project Manager and the project consultant both indicated that the project has a strong chance to obligate this year. We are in "use it or lose it". This may be our best option to use our remaining STP funds. **It is recommended that STP is used to fund the full \$532,282 (total project cost).**

**SEAGO Traffic Count Program Continuation (SEA15-01):** As a result of the adjustments to Davis Road, SEAGO has STP funds that must be spent this year. SEAGO may roll the Works Consulting contract over one more year. It is recommended that we invest \$125,000 to continue the program and to enhance traffic counting next year.

**Santa Cruz County Pendleton Drive and Palo Parado Intersection Improvements (SCC 12-15):** This project was completed last month. Project change orders resulted approximately \$50,000 in additional construction costs. The TAC voted to increase STP funding for this project by \$50,000. Total STP funding for this project is now \$190,000.

**ADOT Safety Section** has developed a programming plan to deliver our SEAGO HRRRP projects. As per the programming plan, they were programmed in the following manner.

**GGH13-04** (Graham County, Reay Lane Irrigation Canal Ditch Relocation) – ROW; 2015

**GGH13-04** (Graham County, Reay Lane Irrigation Canal Ditch Relocation) – Construction; 2017 - **Construction costs also were amended to \$252,800 (total cost) to match the costs identified in the JPA.**

**GGH12-04** Graham County, 8<sup>th</sup> Ave & Airport Road Intersection – Construction; 2018

**SCC12-03** (Santa Cruz County, Rio Rico and Pendleton Drive Intersection Improvements) – Construction; 2019

**SCC12-12** (Santa Cruz County, River Road and Pendleton Drive Safety Improvements) – Construction; 2019

**GGH12-03** (Graham County, Reay Lane/Safford Bryce Road) – Construction; 2019
