We have reviewed your May 14, 2015 request to amend the FY 2015-2018 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to include the enclosed list of projects approved by the Central Arizona Governments Regional Council on April 29, 2015.

We accept this Amendment in accordance with 23 CFR 450 and find that this STIP amendment was developed based on a continuing, cooperative and comprehensive transportation planning process in accordance with the 23 USC 134 and Section 5303 of the Federal Transit Act (49 USC 53). Dear, Ms. Glendening;

The Central Arizona Governments (CAG) was authorized for \$300,000 in Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) funding for a Strategic Transportation Safety Plan. CAG respectfully requests an additional \$18,000 due to proposals over original estimate and additional work.

CAG Initially divided the safety plan into two phases due to a lack of available HSIP funds. However, CAG was able to identify additional HSIP funding and decided to combine Phase I & II. On April 22nd, the CAG "Multidisciplinary Committee" met and learned that local communities' crash data was not provided to the Arizona Department of Transportation Safety Section. Our Consultant team will be doing more research to determine what crash data may have been missed or not accounted for in the CAG Region.

Based on these events, we are asking for an additional \$18,000 for our Strategic Transportation Safety Plan and this is reflected in our Transportation Improvement Program approved by Regional Council on April 29th in the amount of \$140,000.
