

The following are TIP Amendments to our 2015-2019 TIP that were approved by the TAC at our May 20th meeting:

SAF12-02 (Safford 20th Ave Phase II – ROW): When programmed, this project was broken into 3 phases (Design, ROW and Construction). Design and ROW were programmed for the same year (FY2012). The design phase received federal authorization in FY2012. However, the ROW phase did not go in FY2012. It was not reprogrammed and remained in FY12. This occurred during the time period when ADOT was still allowing STP carryover. Those funds were absorbed back-into the STP program and used on other projects. SEAGO has the STP funds available to re-fund the ROW phase of this project. **If approved, the project will reflect \$129,591 in STP funding and a \$7,833 in Local Match. Total Project Cost is now \$137,424.**

SEA15-02 (SEAGO/SVMPO Regional Strategic Highway Safety Plan Phase 1): The SEAGO Region has approximately \$400,000 in unused HSIP funding due to projects being reprogrammed in FY15. These funds will lapse on June 30, 2015, if not used. The State will be moving to a Statewide HSIP application process in FY2018. In order to be competitive at the State level, a Regional Safety Plan is critical. This plan will strategically align our region with the Arizona SHSP and identify the critical investments needed to address strategic safety goals. SEAGO and SVMPO will partner involving the study. Project estimates are currently being finalized. Projected cost is approximately \$350,000. Any unused remaining HSIP funding will be transferred to a COG/MPO Safety Pool to allow WACOG and FMPO to also kickoff studies this year. **The project will be programmed on the TIP for \$330,050 Federal HSIP funds with a local match of \$19,950 (In-Kind). Total project cost will be \$350,000.**

The following administrative amendment was made:

GRH13-04 (Graham County Reay Lane Irrigation Canal Ditch Relocation – ROW): The Environmental Clearance has not yet been obtained. Therefore, Right of Way acquisition cannot proceed in FY15. The ROW phase was re-programmed for FY16.
