This letter is to inform the Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) Multimodal Planning Division of seven (7) TIP amendments and three (3) administrative amendments to the CAG TIP FY2016 – FY2026 approved by Regional Council on March 23, 2016.

The seven (7) TIP projects that were amended are as follows:

- **PAY 19-02D** – (Intersection of W. Long Horn Rd & S. McLane Rd)
  - Moved from **FY2019** to **FY2016**
- **GIL 17-01D** – (Colcord Rd – End of pavement to Intersection of Morris)
  - Moved from **FY2017** to **FY2016**
  - From **\$100,000** in Federal Funds to **\$100,106** in Federal Funds
  - From **\$10,000** in Local Match to **\$6,054.21** in Local Match
- **GIL 18-01D** – (Golden Hill Rd – US 60 to Main St. Intersection: New)
  - Moved from **FY2018** to **FY2016**
  - From **\$10,000** in Local Match to **\$7,555.67** in Local Match
- **PAY 16-01C** – Tracs # **SX068** – (E. Bonita St. Phase IV – Hwy 87 to Saint Phillips St.)
  - Moved from **FY2016** to **FY2017**
  - From **\$424,464** in Federal Funds to **\$417,160** in Federal Funds
- **GLB 17-01C** – Tracs # **SZ151 01C** – (Oak St. – US 60 to 1<sup>st</sup> St. and Hill St. Baily St. to Broad St – Pavement Rehabilitation & upgrades to sidewalks)
  - Moved from **FY2017** to **FY2018**
  - From **\$330,000** in Federal Funds to **\$417,215** in Federal Funds
  - From **\$19,946.98** in Local Match to **\$25,218.72** in Local Match

- **GLB 18-01C – Tracs # SZ151 01C – (Broad St. Mesquite St. to E. Cottonwood Rehab & upgrades)**
  - Moved from FY2018 to FY2019
  - From \$385,563.14 in Federal Funds to \$417,215 in Federal Funds
  - From \$23,305.51 in Local Match to \$25,218.72 in Local Funds
  
- **PAY 19-01D – (Granite Dells Rd. – Hwy 60 to Mud Springs Rd – Geometric Corrections, Pavement Lift, Bicycle Lanes, Pavement)**
  - Moved from FY2019 to FY2020
  - From \$230,000 in Federal Funds to \$200,000 in Federal Funds

The seven (3) administrative amendments are as follows:

- **GIL 07-01T – Tracs # SL648 – (Six Shooter Canyon)**
  - Moved from FY2018 to FY2016
- **GIL 09-01T – Tracs # SL692 – (Main Street – SR60 to Golden Hill)**
  - Moved from FY2018 to FY2017
- **GIL 10-01T – Tracs # SL722 – (Pine/Strawberry Pedestrian Shelters)**
  - Moved from FY2018 to FY2017
