
Dear Mr. Kies:

We have reviewed your June 7, 2016 request to amend the FY 2016-2019 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to include the enclosed tables of projects approved by the Pima Association of Governments Regional Council as a Transportation Improvement Program amendment on May 26, 2016.

We accept this Amendment in accordance with 23 CFR 450 and find that this STIP amendment was developed based on a continuing, cooperative and comprehensive transportation planning process in accordance with the 23 USC 134 and Section 5303 of the Federal Transit Act (49 USC 53).
