Attached is a revised copy of the Western Arizona Council of Governments (WACOG) 2018–2022 Transportation Improvement Program. This amendment to the WACOG FY 2018 TIP allocates additional STP/STBG funds for the Mohave County – Pierce Ferry Rd CBD Project (MMO 17-102 D/C) to add to the existing project scope, the design and construction of an asphalt-paved non-motorized (pedestrian and bicycle) trail on the north/west side of Pierce Ferry Road from the current project limits at Ironwood Street running northeast for approximately 5,280 linear feet, terminating across from the southernmost driveway of the Mt. Tipton School. The WACOG Transportation Advisory Committee (TAC) approved the FY 2018 TIP Amendment #2 at the TAC’s July 26<sup>th</sup>, 2017 meeting. The WACOG Executive Board approved the FY 2018 TIP Amendment # 2 at the September 21, 2017 Meeting.
