


We have reviewed your February 28, 2018 request to amend the FY 2018-2021 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to include the enclosed table of projects from the FY 2018-2022 Transportation Improvement Program Amendment approved by the Yuma Metropolitan Planning Organization Executive Board on February 22, 2018.



Yuma Metropolitan Planning Organization (YMPO) is requesting the FY 2018-2022 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Amendment #3 approved by the YMPO Executive Board on February 22, 2018 be included in the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). This amendment includes the following changes:

1. City of Yuma, COY-16-01C: HAWK Pedestrian Hybrid Beacon is receiving Federal: \$14,773 of STBG and a Adding a Local Match of \$893.00 and receiving Highway Safety Improvement Program Funds at 100% No Match \$26,625 for a total of \$42,291 combined funds for this project.
2. Yuma County, YC-18-01C: County 14th Street: Ave A to Ave D is receiving \$237,286 STBG funds with a HURF Exchange Rate: \$213,557 added to this project.

An Air Quality Conformity Analysis is not required for the Yuma County and the City of Yuma projects in the FY 2018 Transportation Improvement Program.
