



Dear Mr. Bottjen,

This letter is to inform the Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) Multimodal Planning Division of three (3) amendments to the CAG FY2018 – FY2028 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), which was last approved by the CAG Regional Council on March 28, 2018. The three (3) items that amended the TIP are as follows:

**1. FTA 5310 Grant Applications (Parking Lot Items)**

- a. Town of Florence/Senior Center
  - o Applying for **\$20,000** with a Local Match of **\$20,000** for a total of **\$40,000** towards operations of a Volunteer Program.
- b. Kearny Senior Center
  - o Applying for **\$2,640** with a Local Match of **\$660** for a total of **\$3,300** towards preventive/capital maintenance for existing vehicle.
- c. Payson Senior Center
  - o Applying for **\$23,000** with a Local Match of **\$6,000** for a total of **\$29,000** towards a replacement van.

Parking lot items will be administratively amended to reflect actual awarded amounts upon approval.

**2. PRTA-01 – Cordones Road - Construction**

- a. Pinal Regional Transportation Authority (PRTA) Project within the CAG Transportation Planning Boundary for FY 2019.
- b. Total allocated PRTA Tax Revenue = **\$2,500,000**.

**3. Pinal Regional Transportation Authority - Allocations**

- a. Towns of Superior, Kearny, and Mammoth to receive **\$300,000** annually for FY 2019-FY2023, which represents the first five (5) years (Phase I) of the 20-year tax.
- b. Specific projects will be amended administratively once identified and approved through the PRTA Board.
