We have reviewed your August 9, 2018 request to amend the FY 2018-2021 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to include the enclosed list of projects approved as FY 2018-2022 Transportation Improvement Program Amendment 10 by the Maricopa Association of Governments Regional Council Regional Council on June 28, 2018.

The Maricopa Association of Governments' (MAG) Fiscal Year (FY) 2018-2022 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), approved by the MAG Regional Council on June 28, 2017, requires amendments and administrative project modifications which are included in Tables A, B, and C. These amendments and administrative modifications serve as necessary project advancement modifications and detailed TIP listings for obligation authority distributions from Federal Highway Administration and related work phase changes. This action was approved by the MAG Regional Council as part of agenda item 5D on June 27, 2018. Additionally a sheet of administrative modifications, identified as Table D, is included in this request as Administrative Modifications to the MAG TIP that are not required to be heard by Regional Council.
