We have reviewed your April 22, 2019 request to amend the FY 2019-2023 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to include the enclosed tables of projects approved by the Pima Association of Governments Regional Council as Transportation Improvement Program amendment #8 on March 28, 2019.
