Dear Jason,

The City of Show Low is requesting a modification of NACOG's FY2019 - 2024 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to increase additional funding for a project utilizing STBG funds in FY 2019 for the SR-260 and Show Low Lake Road Intersection Improvements. Additionally the City is requesting transferring FY21 HURF Exchange construction funding to STBG (to allow eventual transfer of funds to an ADOT project). The functional classification of the intersection is Principal Arterial.

The purpose for this amendment is to add \$100,000 of Federal funds available from existing unallocated funds in the current year to initiate design. This project is located in the City of Show Low in Navajo County and the scope of work includes realignment of the intersection, installation of new right turn lanes, and the installation of a new traffic signal at the intersection. The City is currently proposing to combine this project with an existing ADOT project to create one construction season and save on construction costs. The allocation of these funds is for design only and is being requested based on the unallocated balance currently in the region.
