The Eastern Federal Lands Highway Division (EFLHD) has developed a Mid-Year Update for the FY 2019-2022 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for transportation projects within Federal Lands. The Federal requirement under Title 23 U.S.C. § 204 requires that the TIP be developed as part of the transportation planning process for Federal Lands projects.
