We have reviewed your June 3, 2019 request to amend the FY 2019-2023 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to include the enclosed list of projects approved by the Yuma Metropolitan Planning Organization Executive Board on May 30, 2019 as FY 2018-2022 Transportation Improvement Program Amendment 6.



Dear Mark,

Yuma Metropolitan Planning Organization (YMPO) is requesting the FY 2018-2022 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Amendment #6 approved by the YMPO Executive Board on May 30, 2019 be included in the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). This amendment includes the following changes:

1. Yuma County's FY 2019 - YC-BR-05C: Bridge #7751 & YC-BR-06C: #8865 funding has increased at the request of Yuma County using Surface Transportation Block Grant Funds (STBG) funds to construct the project in the amount of Federal STBG – \$82,778, Local Match - \$5,004, Total - \$87,782. An additional Off-System Bridge fund of \$462,298 were added to this project.
2. Yuma County is requesting the FY 20 YC-20-02D: Ave B – Mile and Fill: 24th Street to 32nd Street Design funds: Federal STBG – \$150,000 exchanged to HURF be moved to the Construction phase in FY 22 to maximize construction phase. Yuma County will do Design In-House to Federal Standards for HURF Exchange program. Construction will increase HURF Funds to \$810,000 or Federal STBG – \$900,000.
3. The Town of Wellton WEL-14-01C Coyote Wash MUP funding has increased at the request of Wellton using STBG funds to construct the project in the amount of Federal STBG - \$82,859, Local Match - \$5,008, Total - \$87,867.

An Air Quality Conformity Analysis is not required for the Yuma County Projects and the Town of Wellton in the FY 2018-2022 Transportation Improvement Program.
