Dear Mr. Mendez:

We have reviewed your August 12, 2004 request to amend the FY 2004-2006 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to add five new projects and modify funding levels for several other projects in the NACOG region. Tables for these projects are enclosed.
