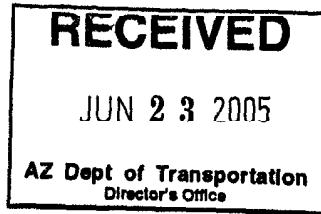


Dear Mr. Mendez:

We have reviewed your April 21, 2005 request to amend the FY 2005-2007 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to include the projects approved by the PAG Regional Council on July 22, 2004, August 26, 2004, October 27, 2004, November 17, 2004, December 15, 2004, January 13, 2005, and March 23, 2005 in the PAG region.

Subject: TIP Subcommittee Report

Background:

The TIP Subcommittee has recommended a change to the 2005-2009 TIP as follows:

Item A - This is a request from the City of Tucson's transit office to increase the funding level for project #35.03 Transit Alternatives Analysis to reflect additional funding that has been made available to them from FTA, and to transfer the FY2004 carryover funding from project #27.03 Van Tran Replacement Vans to project #29.03 Van Tran Expansion Vans. The City has determined that replacement vans will not be needed this year and the monies can more effectively be used to expand the Van Tran fleet. All of these changes involve FTA 5307 transit funds.

Item B - This is a request from ADOT to synchronize the PAG TIP with work they are currently planning related to the Marsh Station TI on I-10. The original project intended that the TI would be reconstructed to improve the safety conditions related to the railroad overpass adjacent to it. Since the project was initiated however the State has successfully negotiated an agreement with the Union Pacific Railroad to relocate the tracks to the north side of the interstate, thereby eliminating the need for two railroad bridges in the area. The revised project will provide for the relocation of the railroad, removal of the old railroad bridges, and upgrading of the mainline and TI ramps. The work items and schedules are being revised but the total cost of the revised program remains unchanged.

Item C - This is a request from ADOT to reprogram \$400K from the Scoping Contingency Pool (TIP ID #750.00) to two state projects for the purpose of beginning the initial scoping study work. \$200K each will be provided to project #11.02, SR 77 Tangerine Rd. to Pinal County Line, and project #2.02, SR 86: Valencia to Kinney.

Item D - Is a request from ADOT to increase the program funding for TIP project # 47.01 - Duval Mine Rd. TI, to reflect \$300,000 in State Enhancement funds that have been added to the project. These are state funds and will have no impact on the PAG budgets.

The details of the new TIP listings are shown in the tables below.

Discussion Points:

The proposed changes will not have a substantive affect on the air quality conformity findings or fiscal constrain analysis of the TIP.

Recommendation:

The TIP Subcommittee, Transportation Planning and Management Committees recommend the Regional Council approve Amendment #1 to the FY 2005-2009 Transportation Improvement Program.

Suggested Motion:

That the Regional Council of the Pima Association of Governments approves Amendment #1 of the FY2005-2009 TIP as shown on attachment # _____ .
