We have reviewed your June 15, 2006 request to amend the FY 2006-2008 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to reschedule the projects in the enclosed table. These changes to the Pima Association of Governments (PAG) TIP were approved by the PAG Regional Council on May 31, 2006.
