Dear Mr. Mendez:

We have reviewed your July 24, 2006 request to amend the FY 2006-2008 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to include the 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue Safford Bridge Project listed on the enclosed table. These changes to the Southeastern Arizona Government Organization (SEAGO) TIP were approved by the SEAGO Executive Board on June 10, 2006.

We accept this Amendment in accordance with 23 CFR 450 and find that this STIP amendment was developed based on a continuing, cooperative and comprehensive transportation planning process in accordance with the 23 USC 134 and Section 5303 of the Federal Transit Act (49 USC 53). #### Dear Arnold:

Graham County has asked SEAGO to add a Bridge Repair and Replacement project to our current Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). As you are no doubt aware, the county currently has two bridge projects underway for the Safford Bridge, one for design for \$1,000,000 and one that is a High Priority Project identified in federal legislation for slightly less than \$7,000,000.

However, the county feels that this will not be enough funding to complete this project, and is therefore looking for additional funding to do some of the required work, in this case the approaches to the bridge.

This amendment to the current SEAGO TIP adds a BRR project for \$1,000,000 for the Safford Bridge. Please let me know if there is anything else I need to do in order to include this project in the TIP.

This Bridge project has been a topic of discussion at SEAGO meetings for over a year now. The meeting dates and times where the TIP was discussed are included below for your information. The SEAGO TIP is a standing agenda item for all SEAGO TAC, Administrative Council, and Executive Board meetings.
