Dear Mr. Mendez:

We have reviewed your August 24, 2006 request to amend the FY 2006-2008 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to include the projects listed in Tables 1 and 2 of the enclosure. These changes to the Maricopa Association of Governments (MAG) TIP were approved by the MAG Regional Council on July 26, 2006.

We accept this Amendment in accordance with 23 CFR 450 and find that this STIP amendment was developed based on a continuing, cooperative and comprehensive transportation planning process in accordance with the 23 USC 134 and Section 5303 of the Federal Transit Act (49 USC 53).
