Dear Mr. Mendez:

We have reviewed your July 30, 2007 request to amend the FY 2007-2011 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to revise the project scope for the joint Navajo County/ Town of Snowflake Concho/Snowflake Highway Project to modify the project limits to include only those portions located within the Town of Snowflake. The Northern Arizona Council of Governments (NACOG) approved this amendment on June 28, 2007.

We accept this Amendment in accordance with 23 CFR 450 and find that this STIP amendment was developed based on a continuing, cooperative and comprehensive transportation planning process in accordance with the 23 USC 134 and Section 5303 of the Federal Transit Act (49 USC 53).
