Dear Mr. Mendez:

We have reviewed your December 13, 2007 request to amend the FY 2008-2011 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to include the revised Table 10 entitled Transportation Enhancement Projects and the project name for Somerton in 2008 to "Fern St. to US HWY 95" in Table 4. These changes to the Yuma Metropolitan Planning Organization (YMPO) TIP were approved by the YMPO Executive Board on December 13, 2008.
