Dear Mr. Mendez:

We have reviewed your March 25, 2008 request to amend the FY 2008-2011 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to include two Federal funded projects as approved by the Northern Arizona Council of Governments Regional Council on February 21, 2008. The projects are Conduct Bridge Inspections in Coconino County (FY08 \$27,000) and Page North Navajo Drive Reconstruction (FY10 \$324,444 to HURF).

We accept this Amendment in accordance with 23 CFR 450 and find that this STIP amendment was developed based on a continuing, cooperative and comprehensive transportation planning process in accordance with the 23 USC 134 and Section 5303 of the Federal Transit Act (49 USC 53). The changes made to the program by this amendment are either exempt or are regarded as minor project revisions that do not require conformity determinations [40 CFR §93.126].
