As the Governor's designee, I approve the action taken by the South Eastern Arizona Governments Organization (SEAGO) Executive Board on March 8, 2008, to amend the SEAGO 2008-2012 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). This TIP amendment reflects the 2007 Transportation Enhancement awards for the City of Sierra Vista, and the City of Bisbee. It also includes the Forest Service Bicycle Stop project at Three-Way, near Duncan, which was inadvertently removed from our 2006 TIP, and was not included in the 2007 or 2008 TIP.
