Dear Mr. Mendez:

We have reviewed your April 30, 2008 request to amend the FY 2008-2011 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to include the enclosed table of fifteen projects which includes eleven Federal funded and four State funded. Of the eleven, three are new projects. The other eight Federal projects involve changes in funding, scope or both.
