Dear Mr. Mendez:

We have reviewed your June 30, 2008 request to amend the FY 2008-2011 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to include the enclosed table of projects which was approved by the Maricopa Association of Governments Regional Council on June 25, 2008.

We accept this Amendment in accordance with 23 CFR 450 and find that this STIP amendment was developed based on a continuing, cooperative and comprehensive transportation planning process in accordance with the 23 USC 134 and Section 5303 of the Federal Transit Act (49 USC 53). Dear Director Mendez:

On July 25, 2007, the MAG Regional Council approved the FY 2008-2012 MAG Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). On June 25, 2008 the MAG Regional Council approved the Interim Closeout and recommended that the FY2008-2012 TIP is amended and modified to allow the Closeout projects to proceed. Details of these project changes are shown in the attached table. As the Governor's designee for approval of TIP's and TIP amendments, we request your approval of the amendment and modification of the TIP, which are necessary to ensure the continuation of the projects involved. In addition to approval of the TIP amendment and modification, we also request that ADOT process the necessary amendment to the relevant Statewide Transportation Improvement Program.
