



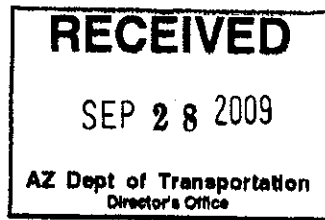


Dear Mr. Hollis:
