We have reviewed Ms. Toth's January 11, 2010 request to amend the FY 2010-2013 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to include the enclosed tables of projects which were approved by the Pima Association of Governments Regional Council as TIP Amendment 3 on December 10, 2009 and TIP Amendment 4 on December 18, 2009.




