We have reviewed Ms. Toth's March 29, 2010 request to amend the FY 2010-2013 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to include the enclosed tables of projects approved by the Pima Association of Governments Regional Council as TIP Amendment 7 on March 25, 2010.


Dear Mr. Hollis:
