We have reviewed Ms. Toth's March 30, 2010 request to amend the FY 2010-2013 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to include the TIP Amendment 8 which was approved administratively on March 29, 2010. This amendment does not include any Federally Funded projects but does create locally funded design projects to prepare for possible future Economic Recovery funded projects.
