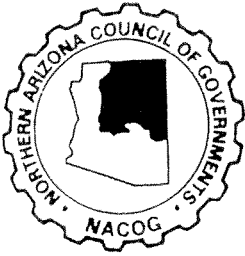

Re: NACOG Region TIP Amendments

Dear Mr. Zumpf: 

The NACOG Regional Council unanimously approved several amendments to the regional transportation improvement program on April 22, 2010. Below is a summary of the changes:

- City of Williams – funds re-programmed from Grand Canyon Blvd to Morse Avenue. Project deferred to FY 2011 to meet project development timelines.
- Yavapai County – funds re-programmed from Fain Road to Pioneer Parkway. FY 2014 funds advanced to FY 2011.
- Town of Eagar – Butler Street project deferred to FY 2012 to meet project development timelines.
- Town of Springerville – Pima Street project deferred to FY 2012 to meet project development timelines.
- City of Winslow – Transcon Lane project deferred to FY 2012 to meet project development timelines.
- Town of Pinetop-Lakeside – Billy Creek Bridge replacement: FY 2010 funds allocated to Navajo County for the same project combined with FY 2011 funds allocated to Town of Pinetop-Lakeside. Additional \$1.0M Bridge Replacement project funding also programmed. All funds for this project now programmed in FY 2012.
- City on Winslow – new HSIP project.
- Coconino County – new HSIP project.
- Four new Safe Routes to School projects added to the program in FY 2011, as recommended by ADOT's Safe Routes to School Selection Committee, for the following communities:
 - Town of Camp Verde: \$245,000
 - Town of Pinetop-Lakeside: \$248,800
 - City of Holbrook: \$248,531
 - Town of Clarkdale: \$158,549
- New line item combining all funds for Safe Routes to School Non-Infrastructure planning projects.
