We have reviewed your July 8, 2010 request to amend the FY 2010-2013 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to include the \$2.5M Lukeville Port of Entry (H745001C) project which will utilize Federal funds. The Arizona-Mexico Commission will contribute \$1M to the project.
