

**Re: NACOG Region TIP Amendments**

Dear Mr. Zumpf: 

The NACOG Regional Council unanimously approved several amendments to the NACOG Regional Transportation Improvement Program on June 24, 2010. Below is a summary of the changes:

- Yavapai County – Pioneer Parkway project length decreased to 2.2 miles.
- Town of Clarkdale – STP funds increased by \$345,000 from STP funds re-allocated from Yavapai County's ARRA/STP funded Cornville Road project
- City of Show Low – Remaining STP balance from city's ARRA/STP funded Penrod Road project was re-programmed for a new project on Whipple Road.
- City of Page – STP funding was reprogrammed from Coppermine Road to South Navajo Drive.

In order to allow these local agencies to begin development of their respective projects, NACOG is requesting that the State Transportation Improvement Program be amended to include these projects. Details are included in the attached NACOG Regional Transportation Improvement Program.
