Dear Ms. Toth:

We have reviewed your December 14, 2010 request to amend the FY 2010-2013 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to include the enclosed table of projects adopted by the Maricopa Association of Governments Regional Council on December 8, 2010 as a Transportation Improvement Program Amendment.

We accept this Amendment in accordance with 23 CFR 450 and find that this STIP amendment was developed based on a continuing, cooperative and comprehensive transportation planning process in accordance with the 23 USC 134 and Section 5303 of the Federal Transit Act (49 USC 53). The changes made to the program by this amendment required a new conformity determination [40 CFR §93.126]. A new finding of conformity was issued by the Federal Highway Administration and Federal Transit Administration on January 4, 2011.

This letter constitutes approval and inclusion of Amendment 76 into the Arizona FY 2010-2013 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). Our approval is based upon the Arizona Department of Transportation's assurance that the funding for the projects in this amendment will not adversely impact the STIP Financial Plan. 

On July 28, 2010, the MAG Regional Council approved the FY 2011-2015 MAG Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). On December 8, 2010, the MAG Regional Council approved an amendment and an administrative modification to the FY 2011-2015 MAG TIP. This amendment and administrative modification includes both highway and transit projects in the MAG region. Details of these project changes are shown in the attached table. As the Governor's designee for approval of TIPs and TIP amendments, we request your expeditious approval of the amendment and modification of the TIP, which are necessary to ensure the continuation of the projects involved. In addition to approval of the TIP amendment and modification, we also request that ADOT process the necessary amendment to the relevant Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) as soon as possible.

We look forward to a continuing close relationship with the State in meeting the transportation needs of our region.
