We have reviewed your January 28, 2011 request to amend the FY 2010-2013 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to include the enclosed table of projects which was approved by the Pima Association of Governments (PAG) Regional Council on January 27, 2011 as a Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) amendment. 
