We have reviewed Mike Normand's May 2, 2011 request to amend the FY 2011-2014 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to include the enclosed list of projects approved by the Northern Arizona Council of Governments (NACOG) Regional Council on April 28, 2011. Alexander Smith of the Federal Transit Administration approved the transit portion of this amendment as an administrative amendment in an email to the Arizona Department of Transportation on May 27, 2011.

**Re: NACOG Region TIP Amendments**

Dear Mr. Zumpf:

The NACOG Regional Council unanimously approved several amendments to the NACOG TIP on April 28, 2011. Below is a summary of the changes:

- City of Show Low – new FY 2011 design project added for design of the Whipple Road STP project.
- Coconino County – new FY 2011 High Risk Rural Roads Program project added on Leupp Road.
- Coconino County – FY 2011 Lake Mary Road HSIP funds increased to \$600,000.
- Williams Unified School District – new Williams Elementary/Middle School SRTS project added in FY 2011. This addition was approved in September 2010 but was not previously listed in the TIP.
- NAIPTA – A new transit table has been added to the TIP to include Section 5309 funds awarded for replacement vehicles for the Cottonwood-Sedona commuter service. The transit table is on a separate tab in the electronic TIP file.

In order to allow these local agencies to begin development of their respective projects, NACOG is requesting that the State Transportation Improvement Program be amended to include these projects. Details are included in the attached NACOG Regional Transportation Improvement Program FY 2011 – 2014.
