We have reviewed your August 23, 2011 request to amend the FY 2011-2014 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to include the enclosed Transportation Improvement Program for FY 2012-16 approved by the SouthEastern Arizona Governments Organizations Executive Board on May 13, 2011.
