We have reviewed your October 19, 2011 request to amend the FY 2011-2014 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to include Amendment 2 to the FY 2012-2016 Transportation Improvement Program adopted by the Yuma Metropolitan Planning Organization Executive Board on August 11, 2011.





Enclosed is the YMPO 2011-2016 revised TIP that was approved by the Executive Board at its regular meeting on August 11, 2011.

The YMPO TIP Amendment 2 includes adding two Safe Routes to School (SRTS) projects to 2012, adding the Yuma County Avenue E Extension CBI project to 2012, deleted the 2012 Yuma County South Frontage Road project and added the federal funding to the same project in 2013, added the City of Somerton Avenue B HSIP design project to 2012, added the City of Yuma 22nd St HSIP project to 2013 and increased the federal funding for the City of Somerton Ave B intersection HSIP construction project in 2013. Changes to the YMPO Transit TIP include expanding project descriptions with ALI's for each year. The TIP modifications included revised listing of current Executive Board Members, revised local project listing located in the Appendix and TIP project costs were updated.
