We have reviewed your November 2, 2011 request to amend the FY 2011-2014 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to include the enclosed list of projects adopted by the Northern Arizona Council of Governments Regional Council on October 27, 2011 as a Transportation Improvement Program Amendment. Since the current approved STIP only covers FY 2011-2014, this action will only consider projects for FY 2012-2014.



Attached is the updated NACOG Regional Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for FY 2012 – 2016, as amended by the NACOG Regional Council on October 27, 2011. This STIP amendment includes one amendment to the TIP and one administrative adjustment. Both are described below.

City of Holbrook – McLaws Road (TIP Amendment)

The city has requested a modification of the project limits to begin further west on McLaws Road since the project within the current limits was completed in a joint effort between the city and Navajo County. The new project limits extend along McLaws Road from Hennessey to Porter Canyon Road.

The city has also requested to utilize up to 15 percent of the federal Surface Transportation Program (STP) funds programmed for the project for project design and clearances. This request is now identified in the TIP as a separate line item in FY 2012.

Town of Camp Verde – Finnie Flat Road Sidewalks (Administrative Adjustment)

The town has requested revisions to more accurately define the project scope to include design and right-of-way acquisition, as well as a nominal increase in federal funds of \$12,550. Revised funding amounts for the federal and local shares, and total project cost, are reflected in the attached revision.

In order to allow the local agencies to begin development of their respective projects, NACOG is requesting that the State Transportation Improvement Program be amended to include these revisions.
