We have reviewed your November 7, 2011 request to amend the FY 2011-2014 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to include the enclosed tables of projects adopted by the Western Arizona Council of Governments Executive Board on June 9, 2011 as the FY 2012-2016 Transportation Improvement Program and October 13, 2011 as Transportation Improvement Program Amendment #1. Since the current approved STIP only covers FY 2011-2014, this action will only consider projects for FY 2012-2014.

We accept this Amendment in accordance with 23 CFR 450 and find that this STIP amendment was developed based on a continuing, cooperative and comprehensive transportation planning process in accordance with the 23 USC 134 and Section 5303 of the Federal Transit Act (49 USC 53). 

Attached is a copy of the Western Arizona Council of Governments (WACOG) 2012 TIP Amendment #1. WACOG requests this amendment be reviewed and processed by ADOT.

The 2012 TIP amendment #1 includes:

- Bullhead City HSIP (BUL12 107): Project Amount Change from \$207,986 to \$201,986. (Some components of this project were ineligible, requiring a reduction in the amount.)
- Mohave County HRRRP Roadway Project (MO12-110): Added to TIP and split project on TIP to show match required components vs. non-match components.
- Colorado River Indian Tribe (ICR12-111): Fed Des Funds for Construction Project.
- Kaibab Paiute Tribe (IKP12-112): Fed Des Funds for a Shared Use Pathway.
- Hualapai Tribe and Mohave County (IHN12-113): Tiger Grant Application Submission.
- Recalculated the match formula to match JPA outcomes on all projects.




