We have reviewed your November 18, 2011 request to amend the FY 2011-2014 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to include the enclosed list of projects adopted by Central Yavapai Metropolitan Planning Organization Executive Board on November 16, 2011. This list incorporates the entire FY 2012-2016 Transportation Improvement Program and three amendments. Only the FY 2012-2014 portion of the list will be amended into the current FY 2011-2014 STIP.


