
Thank you for your letter, dated February 6, 2012, approving the Flagstaff Metropolitan Planning Organization (FMPO) request to amend the FY 2011-2014 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to include TIP amendment #47, for the programming of lapsing transit funds received by NAIPTA from CYMPO through ADOT and for a Small Transit Intensive Cities grant.

The amendment was developed by a process in accordance with 23 USC 134 and 49 USC 53. Transit Element projects are exempt from air quality conformity determination. Our finding was coordinated with the Federal Highway Administration.

This letter constitutes approval of the amendment into the Arizona Statewide Transportation Improvement Program, with the understanding that the eligibility of individual projects for funding is subject to the applicants' satisfaction of all administrative requirements.

I am pleased to submit the following request for an amendment to the FMPO FY 2012-2016 Transportation Improvement Program for your consideration.

The FMPO Executive Board approved these TIP amendments on January 25, 2012. The Northern Arizona Intergovernmental Public Transportation Authority recently received the following two awards of section 5307 funds:

- Small Transportation Intensive Cities – from Federal Transit Administration based on successful performance targets. **\$388,000**; programmed for operating assistance.
- Central Yavapai MPO –from Arizona Department of Transportation based on the lapsing status of the funds at CYMPO and the readiness to utilize the funds by NAIPTA, **\$2,688,000**; programmed for hybrid electric bus replacement.

These amendments are further detailed in attached FMPO TIP Table 5.

The ADOT Transit staff continues supportive in the advancement of transit and transportation goals in the region and across the state.
