





On July 28, 2010, the MAG Regional Council approved the FY 2011-2015 MAG Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). Since then, MAG Regional Council has approved ten project change sheets to amend and administratively modify the TIP. On February 22, 2012, the MAG Regional Council approved the twelfth amendment and an administrative modification to the FY 2011-2015 MAG TIP. This amendment and administrative modification is related to highway and transit projects in the MAG region. Details of these project changes are shown in the attached table.
