

SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF 2012-2016 TIP AMENDMENT #4

Listed below were amendments made to the TIP at the March 8, 2012, TAC meeting:

Cochise County: On January 26, 2012, Cochise County requested a change to the TIP so that the TIP matches their Davis Road Improvement project IGA with ADOT. SEAGO has verified the total dollars awarded to these projects has not changed and the dollar amounts match Cochise County's IGA with ADOT. To complete this process the following changes were made:

CCH15-01: MP 5 ROW was reduced to \$18,860 federal/\$1,140 local match (Total \$20,000).

CCH12-10: MP 13 Construction was reduced to \$924,560 federal/\$55,885 local match (Total \$980,445).

CCH15-01: MP 5 Construction was increased to \$2,404,461 federal/\$145,339 local match (Total \$2,549,800).

CCH15-01: Davis Road MP #5 ROW (CCH15-01) up from FY2015 to FY2012. ROW cost is \$18,860.

City of Sierra Vista: The City requested an increase in FY2012 funding in order to complete their 7th Street Overlay project. At the November 17, 2011, TAC meeting, Sierra Vista was awarded \$959,584, for the project. At the time of approval, the City provided a preliminary cost estimate. As the project was further developed, Sierra Vista was able to provide a more specific cost estimate of \$1,325,191. In order to spend all FY2012 STP funds, the TAC awarded the balance of FY2012 STP funds in the amount of \$327,054, to the City of Sierra Vista. The following change was made:

SVS 12-04: Federal funds increased to \$1,286,638. Match increased to \$77,771. Total increased to \$1,364,409.

Douglas Chino Road Extension Project: This project was initially on the TIP for CBI funding in the amount of \$1,862,200. The TAC approved an increase in CBI funding for this project to \$3,087,200 (\$1,225,000 increase) in order to have design and environmental funding so that the project could be extended SR80.

DGS 12-05: The project was broken down into phases and has been integrated into the TIP in the following manner:

City of Douglas Fountain Restoration: The fountain project is currently on the TIP for \$317,355 for construction. SEAGO was advised that the project was approved an additional \$120,000 for design. The following change was made.

DGS-TE-14: A design phase was added to the TIP for \$120,000 with a match of \$6,840. Total is \$126,840.
