City of Douglas Paseo De La Amistad Multi Use Pathway Project: This was originally an ARRA project that has been completed. The City of Douglas was recently approved by ADOT for reimbursement in the amount of \$215,020.00. Transportation Enhancement funding will be utilized. In order to complete reimbursement, the project needs to be added to the TIP. The City of Douglas is responsible for a 5.7 percent match of \$12,256.14.
