Listed below were amendments made to the FY 2013-2017 TIP as the result of the July 19<sup>th</sup> and September 20<sup>th</sup> TAC meetings:

**Greenlee County:** According to ADOT, the Soap Box Canyon Bridge (Structure 8149) is eligible for replacement. ADOT provided Greenlee County cost estimate of \$750,000 to replace the structure. On July 19, 2012, the TAC approved placing the project on the TIP. It has been added in the following manner:

**Graham County:** The Reay Lane Irrigation Ditch Relocation Project was originally placed on the TIP in two phases (Preliminary Engineering & Design in FY 2013 and Construction in FY 2017). ADOT has requested Right of Way Acquisition be separated from the preliminary engineering phase and placed in FY2014. Anticipated cost of Right of Way Acquisition is \$22,000. **Total project costs have not changed.** The project has been administratively changed in the TIP in the following manner:

**Sierra Vista:** On July 6, 2012, the City of Sierra Vista submitted a HSIP application for a Sign Replacement project in the amount of \$38,466.40. That application was reviewed by ADOT and was deemed eligible for HSIP funding. On July 18, 2012, the City of Sierra Vista requested increasing the size of their Sign Replacement project. The new cost of the project was \$404,530. At the time of our July 19<sup>th</sup> TAC meeting, the amended application had not been reviewed by ADOT to determine eligibility. The TAC voted to approve both applications with the understanding that if the larger project was deemed eligible it would be placed on the TIP and the smaller project discarded. If the larger project was not deemed eligible, then the already eligible smaller sign project would be added to the TIP. ADOT has deemed the larger project eligible for HSIP funding and it has been added to the TIP in the following manner:

**Willcox:** The City of Willcox did not have the funding available to meet local match requirements in order to precede with their Arizona Avenue Transportation Enhancement projects. Arizona Avenue Design and Construction TE projects (WLX TE-12) were removed from the TIP per the City's request and written notification from ADOT's Transportation Enhancement Section.

**Douglas:** The Chino Road Extension Project was administratively amended so that the TIP matched the IGA signed by ADOT and the City of Douglas on August 30, 2012. The TIP was amended in the following manner:
