The Maricopa Association of Governments' (MAG) Fiscal Year (FY) 2014-2018 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), approved by the MAG Regional Council on January 29, 2014, requires amendments and administrative project modifications listed as agenda items #6E, 6G, and 9 and listed in Tables A and B, that were approved by the MAG Regional Council on March 26, 2014.
